

Dear Parent/Carer,

Following parent, pupil and staff voice surveys we have agreed a new system for sharing progress data regarding your child.

Throughout the year, you will receive feedback on your child's progress which will now be called **Progress Tracking (PT)** and their Attitude to Learning. In addition to these interim reports, you will receive an annual report.

Progress tracking

Pupils will receive an Interim report after each in school data collection (see example below). This Interim Report will show, for each subject:

- End of Year (EoY) target
- Progress Tracking data (PT) based on progress in classwork, homework and assessments. In KS3 this will be a National Curriculum level. In KS4 and 5 this will be a grade. PT data is colour coded against the EoY target
- Attitude to Learning (ATL) based on the criteria shown below
- Statutory attendance data
- Pastoral information

Attitude to Learning	
Excellent	Always works to the very best of his/her ability. Always well-behaved and takes an active and enthusiastic part in learning experiences.
Good	Works to the best of his/her ability. Well behaved and generally takes an active part in learning activities.
Satisfactory	Inconsistent effort is made and/or sometimes demonstrates behaviour not conducive to effective learning.
Cause for Concern	Minimal effort is made and/or demonstrates frequently disruptive behaviour and an attitude to learning that is detrimental to themselves and others.


